

Companies With Dual-Class Share Structure Materially Outperform

- Along with my financial research team, we evaluated the stock performance of all companies in the Russell 3000 with dual class shares vs. companies in the Russell 3000 with single class shares, through October 3, 2024. We found that the companies with dual class shares, on average, outperform the companies with single class shares across both the short and the long term. (all averages are annualized and were calculated on an equal-weight basis)


- Over the past one year, companies with dual class shares have returned 35.82% vs. 31.36% for companies without dual class shares.
- Over the past five years, companies with dual class shares have returned 9.05% vs
 8.12% for companies without dual class shares.
- Over the past ten years, companies with dual class shares have returned 8.19% vs
 7.45% for companies without dual class shares.
